Our qualified candidates are; Audrey Gibbons, incumbent, and Shawn Brown qualified to run for Glynn County School Board District 5, Bob McKenzie running for Glynn County School Board in District 3, and Allen Booker, incumbent, running for Glynn County Commissioner in District 5. Rebekah Moore qualified to run for the Georgia House of Representatives in District 167.

General Election activities will begin immediately after the conclusion of the primaries.
