News From The State Party

With just a little under two weeks until the June 16th primary runoff, Georgia Democrats are united and building toward November while Republicans are mired in scandal, messy infighting and division.

New reporting today uncovered a corruption and pay-to-play politics scandal that is rocking Derek Dooley's campaign for U.S. Senate, revealing his deep insider connections as he tries to run as a political outsider in the Republican runoff.

Despite more than \$100 million in spending from Republicans (mostly from their own personal fortunes) in the primaries, Democrats out-balloted Republicans by 8 points and 1 million votes, 54-46 - showing that big money can't buy the kind of grassroots momentum and enthusiasm behind Jon Ossoff, Keisha Lance Bottoms, and Democrats at all levels of the ballot.

To keep our momentum going, Senator Ossoff joined more than 100 volunteers in South DeKalb this weekend to officially open our first coordinated campaign office of the cycle - a show of our organizational strength as we build the strongest coordinated campaign this state has ever seen.

There's a lot of work to be done and these races will be the most competitive in the country - but we are building a campaign that can win.
